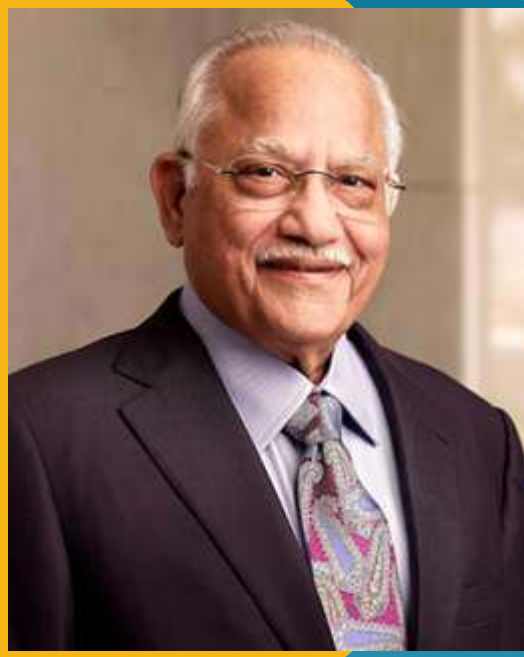
About AHERF
